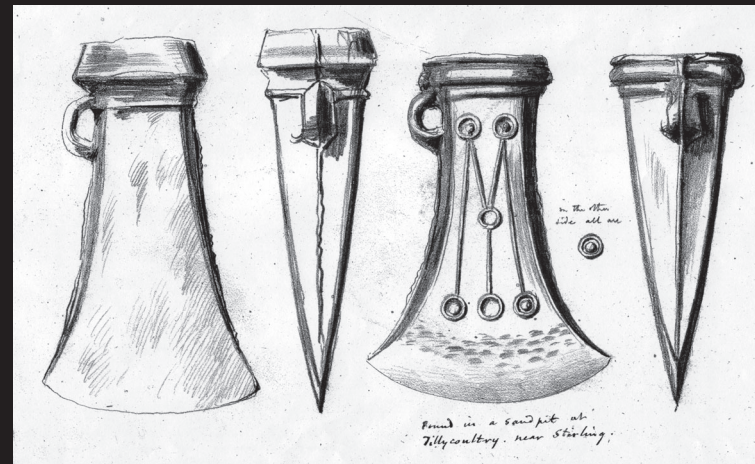

The wide range of papers in this volume include reports on developer funded excavations of multi-period sites at Pitlethie in Fife, along the new road corridor for the A92 in Angus and at a Bronze Age cemetery in Angus. The excavations by the Time Team in Wemyss Caves in Fife are reported on and there are considerations of two late Bronze Age socketed axes from Clackmannanshire, the excavation of the site of a standing stone at Bogleys in Fife and, finally, a report on the extensive excavations in advance of the new concert hall at the Horse Cross in Perth.
