The wide range of papers in this volume include reports on the excavations of several prehistoric sites in Angus as part of the University of Edinburgh's Angus Field School, an appraisal of recently discovered rock carvings in Strath Tay, the reanalysis of a group of medieval pottery from Dundee, recent excavations in the medieval burgh of Perth and the record of the survival of evidence for superstitious practices in a house in Fife.
